Psalm 110 – Jesus is King & Priest

Jesus rules at the right hand of the Father. (verses 1-3)

Jesus is our priest. (verse 4)

Jesus will come again in judgment. (verses 5-7)

Questions for Discussion and Application:

- 1. What was difficult, surprising, or challenging from this passage of Scripture?
- 2. What examples of Christians suffering because of their faith are you familiar with?
- 3. Have you ever felt that Revelation 6:10 was the cry of your heart? Why? Why not?
- 4. Is it surprising to you that Psalm 110 is the most often quoted Psalm in the New Testament? Why do you think this Psalm is quoted so often?
- 5. In what sense is Jesus ruling as King in the world now?
- 6. How is Jesus using your life now to rule in the midst of His enemies?
- 7. How does it comfort and encourage you personally to know that Jesus is seated on the throne in heaven as King now and that all of His enemies will be made a footstool beneath His feet?
- 8. Who is Melchizedek? How is Jesus a priest like him?

9. Why is it true that Jesus is not your King unless He is also your Priest?
10. Who do you know that needs to bow their knee to King Jesus and trust in Him as priest? According to verses 5-6 what will happen to those who don't bow to King Jesus? (see also Philippians 2:9-11 and Revelation 20:15)
