Mere Outward Religion is NOT Enough - Romans 2:1-29

God will judge the unrepentant sinner, both Jew and Gentile.
Merely possessing the Law and the symbol of circumcision will not save.

Questions for Discussion & Application

- 2. Who is Paul speaking of primarily in Romans 2:1-29? (see 2:17)
- 3. What accusation is Paul making of the Jews in 2:1-5?
- 4. According to verse 4, God's kindness is meant to lead one to repentance? What will be the outcome if one persists in unrepentant sin despite the kindness of God? (see 2:5)
- 5. We see in verse 11 that God shows no partiality. What does this mean? Why is this important?
- 6. Why is knowledge of God's commands and mere outward signs (like circumcision for the Jew or baptism for the Christian) not enough to make us right with God?
- 7. What is the true expectation of God? (see Romans 2:29)
- 8. What caution can we take from this passage as Christians today?
