5. What does it mean to "suppress the truth"? What examples of this can we see?
6. Why are all people (even if they do not have the Bible) without excuse for not worshipping God?
7. Due to our rejection of God, what has God given humanity over to? (see verses 24, 26, & 28)
8. How do we see moral disintegration in our own society? What is the true remedy that is most needed for this downward spiral in an individual's life or in a society?
