Humanity has rejected the Creator God for the worship of the creation.

The consequence of this rejection of <u>God</u> is a downward spiral in <u>morality</u>.

- 6. Why are all people (even if they do not have the Bible) without excuse for not worshipping God?
- 7. Due to our rejection of God, what has God given humanity over to? (see verses 24, 26, & 28)
- 8. How do we see moral disintegration in our own society? What is the true remedy that is most needed for this downward spiral in an individual's life or in a society?
