1.	The Holy Spirit <u>lives</u> in you.
2.	God will <u>resurrect</u> your mortal body through His Spirit who lives in you.
3.	You are not a <u>debtor</u> to the sinful nature but a child of God who is led by the Spirit of God.
4.	You are God's adopted child who is rescued from slavery to sin and fear of judgment.

Questions for Discussion & Application

- 1. What questions do you have about today's passage?
- 2. According to verse 9, the Holy Spirit lives in the Christian. In Romans 8:1-16, what is the evidence that the Spirit lives in the Christian?
- 3. What evidence can you see in your own life that the Spirit lives in you?
- 4. As a Christian, how does it encourage you to know that God cares about your physical body and will resurrect it as Jesus' body was raised?
- 5. According to verse 12, the Christian is not a debtor to the sinful flesh? What does this mean?
- 6. How does it encourage you, as a Christian, to be reminded that you are not a debtor to the sinful flesh?
- 7. Since Christians are adopted children of God, we have an intimate relationship with God as our Father. What example can you see from your own life of this closeness with God?
